### 3.1. Number of Teams per class

Men Teams: 15

Women Teams: 9



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## 3.2. Practice Session and Competition Field

The practice field is organized close to the competition field. It'll be open on Thursday from 16:00 to 19:00 and Friday from 09:00 to 12:30 and 15:00 to 19:00

## 3.3. Competition Program (attached)

The latest competition program is published. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date-hour it was printed.

## 3.4 Practice and Warm up

Official Practice (3 hours) on Friday from 16:00 to 19:00, shooting ABC format

Warm up during all days of competition will be scheduled 30 minutes before the Competition session

Warm up for Sunday medal matches will be organized on a side part of the competition Venue.

## 3.5. Equipment Inspection

Equipment inspection will be held following the program of the official practice. Each team will be called (in English alphabetical order by Country/Club Name) and invited by the announcer to the dedicated place for the Equipment inspection on the competition field. Also, all spare equipment must be brought to the equipment inspection.

All team members (archers and officials) should wear their club uniforms and accreditation card.

The correct spelling of athlete's names, as well as the correct date of birth in the archers' list will be checked during the accreditation.

The start numbers will be given at the warmup on the day of the qualification round (it will be distributed on the shooting line, in front of each archer's position).

Access to the competition field is not allowed without accreditation.



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### 3.6. Qualification Round & Information on scoring

Target assignments will be published only on boards and on internet.  
 Shooting in qualifications will be conducted with 3 archers per target in ABC format.  
 For the qualification rounds, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. Please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice.  
 The athletes will have double paper scoring from qualification round till individual bronze medal matches:  
 Scorers provided by organizer will enter arrows in electronic device.

All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

Please instruct your athletes to fill in properly the scorecards including total score, 10's and X's and sign the card before handing them back after each round.

All 15 men teams will be admitted to the pool matches, Only 8 women teams qualify for the pool matches.  
 In case of tied, shoot-off will be arranged only in women event for the 8<sup>th</sup> position.

### 3.7. Pool matches

For the pool matches, no faces will be changed after the practice arrows. So please instruct the archers to mark the arrow holes during practice. Matches will start as soon as the field is ready.

We will keep to the starting time at the beginning of the session and then the competition will run as it goes. Therefore, some matches could start sooner than the time indicated in the schedule. Please be aware of this and be prepared for it.

Please carefully check the schedule.

Men Teams will shoot grouped in 4 pools according to the following scheme:

The Set System will be used. All matches will consist of maximum 4 sets without shoot-off.

In each match 2 “pool points” are allocated based on the outcome of the match: 2 points for the winner and for bye and 0 points to the loser or 1 point each if tie.

At the end of the 3 pool matches, ties in “pool points” are broken by the set points earned during the 3 matches. If still tie a Shoot Off will decide the winner.

- After the pool matches, the pool points allocation and the broken ties this is the situation:

## 3.8 Ranking Matches

### Men teams

The 4 Club teams of same level will then go into a standard semifinals/finals scheme:

- Match 1** (semifinals):           A1 vs D1 and B1 vs C1
- A2 vs D2 and B2 vs C2
- A3 vs D3 and B3 vs C3
- A4 vs D4 and B4 vs C4

**Match 2** (finals): apart the level 1 Club teams, that will do their final match on a final field of play, the winners of the previous match compete for the 1st place, the loser for the 3rd place of their “level”.

### Women Teams

**Match 1** (semifinals): A1 vs B2 and B1 vs A2; A3 vs B4 and B3 vs A4

**Match 2** (finals): winner of A3 vs B4 against winner of B3 vs A4 for the 5 place,





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## 3.9 Final matches

### **Bronze and Gold medal matches**

The 4 final matches (Bronze Women, Bronze Men, Gold Women and Gold Men) will take place on a separate field of play, in alternate shooting and one after the other (see schedule).



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## 3.10 Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

An Appeal form is attached to this document (see attached after this chapter, Appendix 1)  
In case of Intent to Appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission or to his deputy. A fee of 50 € must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal is upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the fee will be returned. In the case of the Appeal being rejected, the fee will not be returned.

## 4) Technical Matters (TD + chairman of Judges)

### 4.1. Timing Control system

The Chronotir timing equipment will be used for timing on the competition and practice field.

### 4.2. Results system

lanseo is the provider of the results. The scoring will be done the archers. In the Qualification two archers will write down the score on the paper scorecards and a scorer from the staff crew will enter on a terminal. In the matches only one scorecard will be filled and signed by the two teams. Terminals are used only during the Qualifications but not during the matches.

### 4.3. Team officials: Archers acting as Coach and Agent

Archers may be acting as coaches only during finals.

For the medal matches each team must appoint an agent for scoring at the target. If needed the Organizing committee will provide one expert archer for that office.

### 4.4. Dress regulation

Athletes, officials, and staff should have a proper appearance when they are on the field during competition. Athletes, team officials and technicians should wear their club team uniforms (with same look per division, following WA rules) and sport shoes.

Opened shoes are not allowed on the field of play.

### 4.5. Lost arrows

We must be sure that no arrow will be left in the grass. All lost arrows are to be reported to judges.

### 4.6. TV Streaming

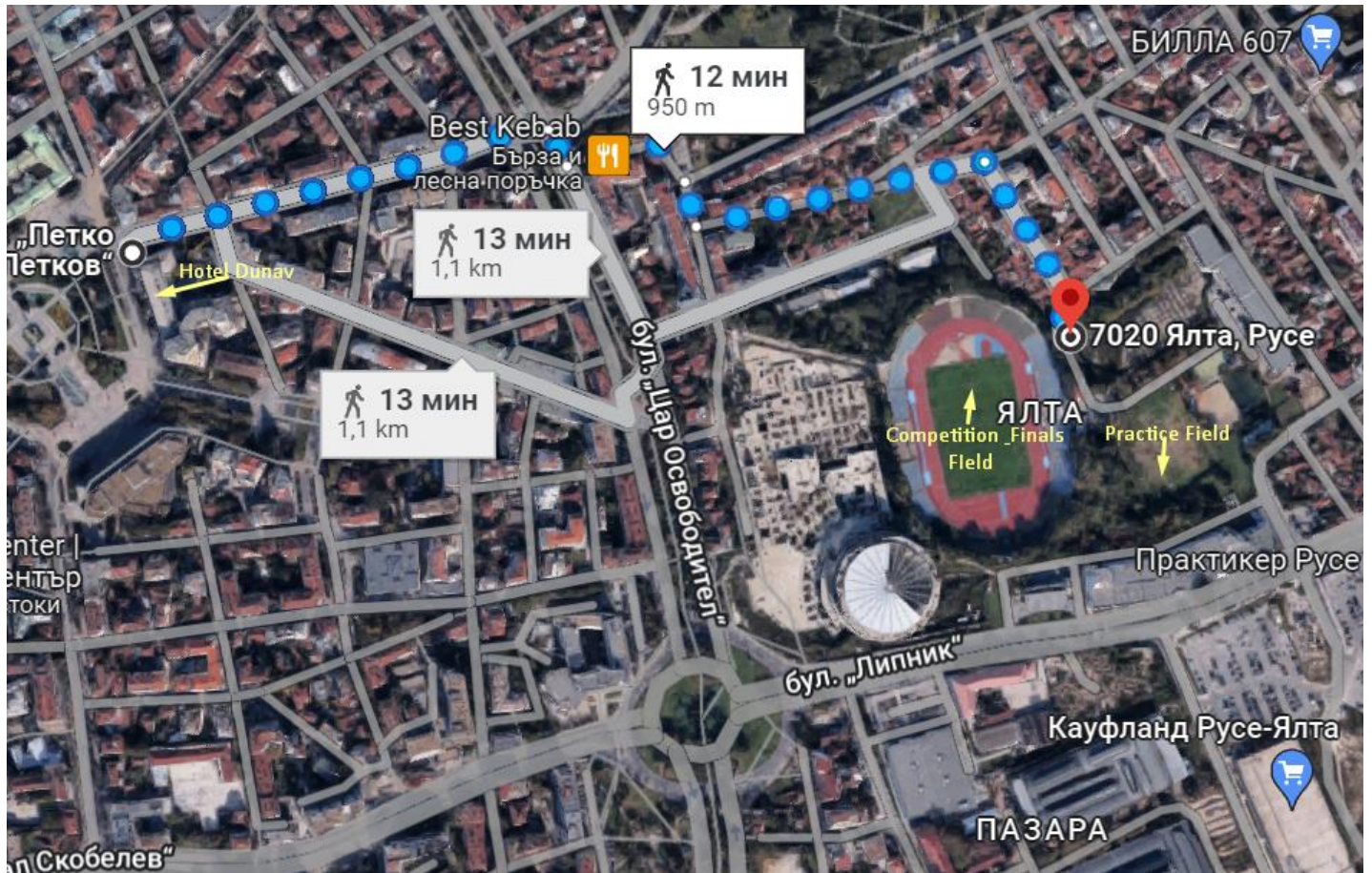
All medal matches will be transmitted on WAE YouTube Channel.

## 5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

### 5.1. Transportation:

Competition is held in complex Yalta, which is in walking distance from the hotel ~1km/~10-12 minutes, however transportation is available as per schedule.

Please be aware that archers with the bow, part of the bow or with arrows in their hands will not be allowed to enter the bus for safety reasons. All such equipment should be placed in the bow case or bag.

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## 5.2. Meals

All meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) will be served at the hotels as per below schedule

## 5.3 Water

Drinking water will be available at breakfast, lunch and dinner free of charge while the other ordered drinks must be paid for.

Drinking water will be available from dispensers on the official field as well.

## 5.4 Accreditation Cards

The accreditation card must be always worn in the practice and competition areas.  
Only archers and their officials who are shooting at that moment can be on the field of play.

## 6. Protocol and ceremonies (OC)

### 6.1. Opening

There will be an Opening Ceremony with welcome speech by the president of the LOC and **the president of the Bulgarian Archery on Friday, after the Official practice.**

### 6.2. Medal Ceremonies and Closing Ceremony

Individual Medal Ceremony will take place at the official field just before Warmup for Pool Matches

Team Awarding ceremony will be at the Competition Field

Prizes:

Prize Money: Total Amount 6.000 €

Recurve Women Club Teams and Recurve Men Club Teams will receive as prize money the following amounts each:

1 <sup>st</sup> place	1.500€
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	1.000€
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	500€

All archers involved in ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point in order to participate to the medal awarding ceremonies.

After awarding, the medalists will have to stay on the field for the picture.

There will be no closing ceremony.

The event will finish officially after the last medal ceremony at the final's venue.

## 7. Medical Related issues (Medical representative)

There is a person responsible for the First Aid on the field and doctor and Ambulance at and First Aid Service are nearby.

In case of emergency during your stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made.

## 8. Doping Control

### 8.1. Doping control

There will be Doping control on this event. This testing session, will be performed in accordance with the WA Anti-Doping Rules and any guidance issued by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).



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## 8.2. Alcohol test

Level of alcohol will be randomly tested during the competition.

## 9. Other matters of importance (WAE TD)

### 9.1. The environment

We ask you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed behind the waiting area.

### 9.2. Water

Water will be available at the main and training.

### 9.3. Nonsmoking and nonalcohol

This is a nonsmoking event for the practice and official competition areas. Inside sport area you are not allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside the sport field. The same is valid also for electronic cigarettes.

Alcohol consumption is forbidden.



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## 9.4. Lost items

All lost items will be brought to the DoS stand, so ask there if you lost something.

## 9.5. Weather

Competitors should plan on bringing a waterproof rain jacket on FOP since it will be raining some days.

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### Article 3.13. WA Rules book

An **intention to appeal** when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. During the Finals of match play rounds, the notice of intent to file an appeal shall be given within five minutes of the end of the match, or prior to the start of the next match, whichever is first.

The **written appeal** shall be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first
